The School Disco


The Discos will be held on Monday 9th December.

for staff and Nursery vehicles will be at the bottom of Newton Drive. This will keep vehicles and pupils separate. Please refrain from trying to drive around the Doctors surgery if unsafe as this could put pedestrians at risk. If you need to drive to school, children can be collected anytime from 2:30pm to avoid congestion at the Chastleton Doctors area. The Black Path will remain closed.
