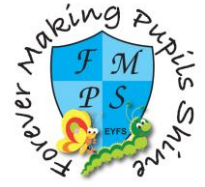

Governing Body

School Disco

The Christmas school disco will be held on Monday 7th December.

KS1 - Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2's disco will be straight after school until **4:30pm**.

At 3:15 pupils who attend the disco can go and get changed into their Disco clothes if they wish to in school. All children will be taken into their own classrooms to be collected. **Therefore Parents can collect from the Nursery door, Reception classroom door, Year 1 and Year 2 door to collect their child.** Your child will receive a selection box before they go home. The cost of the disco is £3.00 and tickets can be bought from the school office on Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th December. Children can bring in the money themselves in purses/envelopes and they purchase the ticket during the day as they enjoy the independence of buying their own tickets. At the last disco there were a few issues with congestion at the Nursery drop off point. To avoid this, could only parents that are collecting children from Nursery use the Nursery drop off point, this is greatly appreciated.



KS2 - Year 3, 4, 5 and 6's disco will start at **4:45** and **please enter via the main entrance**. The disco will finish at **5:45**. Parents need to sign in their child and then leave. **Please collect your child from their classroom via main entrance**. The cost of the Disco is £2.00 and pupils can buy sweets and drinks from the school tuckshop during the disco. Tickets can be bought from school on Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd and Friday 5th. Children can bring in the money themselves in purses/envelopes and they can purchase the ticket during the day.
