
After School Clubs for Spring Term



Dear Supporter,

I am writing to you to give you a brief update regarding the Shoe Box Appeal in 2015. After weeks of hard work by many, many people, after countless acts of generosity and after gathering shoe boxes from all over County Durham and North Yorkshire, the Shoe Box Campaign 2015 came to a very rewarding end just before Christmas. Samaritan's Purse had set us, the Consett warehouse, a target for 2015 of 9848 shoe boxes (yes, I thought it was rather a precise number!) and on Tuesday 1 December, a very dedicated team of volunteers loaded cartons containing 10,336 shoe boxes and four cartons of items for babies onto a lorry bound for Romania. It had been a magnificent effort involving some 1700 volunteer hours just in the warehouse alone. This is in addition to all that has been done in schools, churches and other organisations. I am absolutely delighted with what we have achieved collectively. The commitment and enthusiasm has been outstanding and I feel very privileged to have been a part of this extraordinary team.
