Earrings

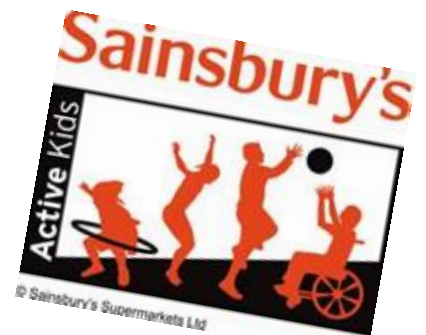
