What were the outcomes for pupils at Framwellgate Moor Primary School in 2018 at the end of Reception?

Question: What proportion of pupils reached a Good Level of Development in 2018?

Answer: Attainment: 75.9% of pupils achieved a GLD

Question: Is this good attainment?

Answer: This is in line with the National Average which is 70.7%

Question: What proportion of pupils reached the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths?

Answer:

- 93% of pupils achieved aged related expectations in Reading
- 93% of pupils achieved age related expectations in Writing
- 93% of pupils achieved age related expectations in Maths

Nationally:

- 76% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in Reading
- 68% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in Writing
- 75% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in Maths

What were the outcomes for pupils at Framwellgate Moor Primary School in 2018 at the end of Key Stage 2 – Year 6?

Question: What proportion of pupils reached the expected standard in Reading, Writing, GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling) and Maths?

Answer:

- 83% of pupils achieved age related expectations in Reading
- 83% of pupils achieved age related expectations in Writing
- 83% of pupils achieved age related expectations in GPS
- 76% of pupils achieved age related expectations in Maths

Nationally:

- 71% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in Reading
- 76% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in Writing
- 77% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in GPS
- 75% of pupils nationally achieved age related expectations in Maths
