Year 1 Parents

You are invited to a Year 1 Parent meeting to discuss how homework works in Year 1. This will be at 9am on Tuesday 15th September 2020. Please wait at the Main Entrance from 9am.

Year 3 Parent

Pupils in Year 3 do not receive free fruit from the Government. However, your child can bring a piece of fruit (not kiwi) into school. Dried fruit is permitted but no breakfast bars or anything containing nuts please.

Year 3 would usually attend swimming lessons from September to March. They would travel to Freemans Quay by bus. We will let you know in September when these lessons may be able to start. It would be useful for your child to practise going to the swimming pool when they open and gain confidence from going in the water. They do not need to be able to swim. Costumes and swimming trunks – not all in ones or bikinis and swimming hats are required by all children. Goggles are only needed if your child wishes to have them. Some pupils like to have the towels with a hole in the middle to put over their head whilst changing but this is their choice.

The school day finishes at 3:20pm and your child needs to know whether to go to Main Gate or Black Path. The children walk with staff to these areas.

Lunches are no longer free in Year 3 and pupils are required to pay £2.10 per day. If you require a user name and password details to access the online lunch payment system called Parent Pay, please ask at the Main Office.



Milk

Pupils entitled to Free School meals will receive a carton of milk if they choose to drink it. If they are in KS2, they can select whether to have it at morning break or at the lunch table instead of water.

Once your child has had their 5th Birthday, they no longer receive free school milk. However, you can order milk through the Cool Milk Scheme and your child can access this in any year group. They can choose whether to drink this at morning break or at lunchtime.

Year 5 and 6 Parents

Walking home alone

There is a slip to sign if your child is in Year 5 or 6 and permitted to walk home alone. Please make sure that this is completed if required.

Those pupils walking home alone may be allowed to keep their phone in the main office during the day. There is a slip for parents to consent to this if required.

Homework – Year 1 to Year 6

Homework will continue to be given on a Thursday and collected in on a Tuesday.

Uniform

The final date for ordering uniform by is Friday 17th July. Any uniform orders not received by the end of term will be able to be collected from the school main entrance on Tuesday 1st and Wednesday 2nd September between 9.00am and 11:30am. Please enter via the Main Entrance. School reopens for pupils on Thursday 3rd September 2020.
