Transition from Nursery to Reception

Enterprise stalls

Nursery children will have the opportunity to visit Enterprise Day led by Year 5 and 6. All of Year 5 and 6 pupils will lead a stall/activity station and plan and prepare this. On Friday 14th July, children can bring in some change with them and visit the stalls in year groups with their teaching staff to enjoy taking part in the activities led by the Y5/6 pupils. Up to £5 will allow your child to choose from games like: 'Hook a duck' and 'Splat the Rat!' 'Name the Teddy' and choose one edible treat and one drink. Please provide change in silver and £1 if possible in a purse/wallet with name on. The staff will then help your child choose and spend their money. All proceeds will be going towards purchasing 30 brand new iPads and a charging trolley. Our iPads are now old and these resources are much needed in school.
